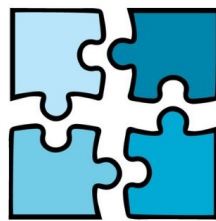

"GAMIFICATION TOOLS FOR YOUTH LEARNING"

"Gamification tools for youth learning is an Erasmus+ KA2 Innovation project applied by EuroFRC with the partnership of KRIK, GYIOT and TNK.

The specific objectives of the project are:

- To provide opportunities for youth workers to involve digital tools when providing youth work activities for young people;
- To involve new digital methods and tools for providing youth work activities;
- The young people to gain knowledge and skills on different topics for their social and personal development using online digital tools
- To motivate and inspire youth to act at local and national level by using their own potential, openness and ideas;
- Offering new opportunities for online learning on different topics providing social and personal development for young people on local and national level.

Travel information

Flight tickets are booked by EuroFRC according to your indications and agreements via email. Each partner should send 4 participants. Trainers will be in charge of directing the activities. **Each participant has a maximum of 275,00 EUR as a travel budget.** Eventual budget excess will be discussed with EuroFRC Coordinators.

Please, collect all travel documents as bus, train and tram tickets and boarding passes in order to deliver to EuroFRC and account the amounts at their maximal for the LTTA. In case of their loss, we won't be able to account them, so try to be treat those with care.

Each participant must have a valid Covid19 EU recognized vaccination in line with the EU regulations.

Special attention to Macedonia: you may need a letter to show to the Border Control for locating your staying, coming from non-Schengen area. Please, contact us ASAP in order to transfer to us the data of the participants.

Once you land to Chopin Airport in Warsaw, you can take a:

1. Train

From Chopin Airport Train station you can arrive at Warszawa Centralna or Warszawa Zachodnia and take a shift to Łódź Fabryczna, Łódź Widzew or Łódź Kaliska.

Tickets must be done earlier at the ticket machine or at frontal spots. If you jump on a train without a ticket, they will make a ticket with a fee that will be paid on spot. Try to avoid such a circumstance, please.


Attention: Warsaw is under modernisation of the entire railway system, which means that departure stations from Warsaw to Łódź may change. For this reason we kindly ask you to consult the official website and locate trains for the date of arrival and departure accordingly: <https://www.pkp.pl/en/>

2. Bus

From Warsaw Chopin Airport to Warsaw West Bus Station and then with Flixbus: <https://global.flixbus.com/bus-routes/bus-warsaw-lodz>

Taxi and on-demand transportation (including Uber and similar) as well first class tickets cannot be covered, as in any other Erasmus+ project.
